# Green Climate Fund, GCF

- The sky is the limit (for good and bad);
- 50% of the total GCF budget is earmarked for Africa;
- FAO is accredited organization;
- FAO can assist on formulating projects;
- Contact point is the FAO country representative in your country;
- New possibility, no prior examples exist – yet;
- IFM is a small (but important) piece, it must be contextualized;

# Global Environmental Fund, GEF

- Several generations - now GEF 7 is about to open;
- Criteria is being developed and finalized – right now;
- Often large projects over several years;
- Co-financing is a key-pillar of GEF. Without this – no project;
- FAO is an executing agency, many projects underway, and planned;
- Contact point is the FAO country representative in your country;
- FAO RAF forestry staff can assist formulating projects proposals;
- IFM is a small (but important) piece, it must be contextualized;

# FAO Technical Co-operation Projects, TCP

- Relatively small, up to a few hundred thousands of dollars;
- Shorter, not meant to be longer than, say, 2 years;
- Managed by the regional FAO office in Accra – rather light admin;
- Contact point is the FAO country representative in your country;
- FAO RAF forestry staff can assist formulating projects;

# FAO EU FLEGT program - I

- Call for proposals open to government, civil society and private sector organizations;
- Offer calls for proposals *not* earmarked for IFM;
- Next Call for Proposals probably around August/September 2017;
- Interested proponents get in contact with their respective FLEGT Facilitator (Ms. Clare Brogan is the Facilitator for Ghana);
- Considering country-specific calls that target priority areas for the country;

# FAO EU FLEGT program - II

There is a higher chance that IFM proposals will be accepted if:

- IFM is particularly needed in the country;
- there is a request/support for IFM at the national level;
- historically IFM has played a role to ensure transparency and better forest monitoring in the country;
- or this is a priority identified through the country's VPA roadmap;
