











VPA TRANSPARENCY GAP ASSESSMENT 2022 INDICATORS BASED ON ANNEX IX OF THE EU-LIBERIA VPA

November 2022

Key Messages

- Liberia's commitment to transparency is enshrined in a number of laws and regulations, reinforced by the Voluntary Partnership Agreement (VPA), which states that provision of information to stakeholders is central to the effective implementation of the agreement, and thus to ensuring legal compliance in the forestry sector. Unfortunately, only 12 of the 52 pieces of information stipulated in Annex IX of the agreement are currently available on any Government of Liberia websites.
- Since the ratification of the agreement in 2013, community forestry has become the predominant management regime in Liberia's forests, but Annex IX does not provide for access to information on community forests. This briefing proposes revisions to remedy this.
- The recent initiative to make a public portal into the LiberTrace system is welcome. This should allow accurate, official, and up-to-date information to be available to all. A web-based portal is ideal for access to 'live' information that changes day-by-day, such as production data and payments. Nonetheless, the more 'fixed' information, such as laws, regulations, and contracts, needs to be published on the pages of the Forest Development Authority's website designated for these documents.

Introduction

The Voluntary Partnership Agreement (VPA) between the European Union (EU) and the Government of Liberia (GoL) commits the two parties to transparency and public access to information. Pursuant to this, Annex IX of the VPA sets out the information that is to be made publicly available.

In 2012, the Sustainable Development Institute (SDI) conducted an assessment of compliance with the provisions in Annex IX.² This briefing repeats that assessment, ten years on, to find out the various categories of information that are currently available for the items listed in the VPA annex.

This briefing also proposes two improvements to Liberia's provision of forest sector information. First, at the time the VPA was agreed, community forests were not included, and yet the majority of timber Liberia produces now comes from these forests. Crucially, the VPA neglects to oblige regular publication of direct payments between companies and communities, or of contributions in kind made by companies, for example for community infrastructure, scholarships etc. The brief therefore identifies where the provisions of the VPA transparency annex need to be expanded to include this sub-sector.

This assessment was conducted by two research consultants under the project "Strengthening the Capacity of Civil Society for the implementation of the VPA", coordinated by Fern and implemented by the Sustainable Development Institute (SDI), Foundation for Community Initiatives (FCI), Civil Society-Independent Forest Monitors (CS-IFM),

National Union of Community Forestry Development Committees (NUCFDC), National Union of Community Forest Management Bodies (NUCFMB), and Liberia Forest Media Watch (LFMW). It was conducted with the financial support of the European Union. The opinions expressed are the sole responsibility of the authors and cannot be taken to reflect the views of the European Union.

Second, as stated in the eighth and ninth meetings of the EU–Liberia Joint Implementation Committee (JIC) of the VPA, the establishment of a public portal to the wood tracking system LiberTrace has been agreed.³ This brief outlines what sort of information should be provided through such a live portal, and what sort of information changes less often and is therefore better suited to being published on the Forest Development Authority (FDA) or other official Liberia websites.

Legal basis

Section 18.15 of the 2006 National Forestry Reform Law (NFRL) lays out clear obligations for the FDA to provide information:⁴

The Authority shall grant and facilitate free public access to read and to copy all documents and other information in its possession, including all audits, all Forest Resources License fee invoices and fee payment information, business and forest management plans, strategies, resolutions from the Board of Directors, public comments, reports, inventories, regulations, manuals, databases, contract maps, and contracts [with certain types of information redacted]. — Section 18.15(a)

As far as practicable, the Authority shall maintain the documents described in Subsection (a) of this Section on the Internet and freely accessible to the public. — Section 18.15(e)

The NFRL pre-dates the 2009 Liberia Extractive Industry Transparency Initiative (LEITI) Act and the 2010 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).⁵ Both these laws strengthen obligations on GoL agencies to publish information, and an Independent Information Commission was established in 2012 to implement the FOIA.⁶

The 2012 VPA, built on Liberia's own legal framework and the Annexes, detail how these commitments might be fulfilled:

The following information described below will be made available to the public by regular publication, as described in Sections 2.5 and 2.6 of the Freedom of Information Act 2010. The information may be provided by various means depending on the nature of the information and the target audience, for example: (a) websites; (b) multi-stakeholder implementation platform; (c) public meetings; (d) press conferences; (e) national radio and newspapers; (f) brochures and newsletters. — Paragraph 1, VPA Annex IX.

(c) establishing an information exchange platform for consistent dissemination of information to domestic and international partners... (e) putting systems in place for the appropriate government authorities to publish information. — Paragraph 10 (2^{nd} part), VPA Annex VIII.

Methodology

The VPA annex lists 52 pieces of information that the GoL has committed to placing in the public domain. The assessment uses a 'traffic lights' system showing whether each piece of information (a) exists (as far as the research was able to ascertain), and (b) is on the FDA or other official GoL websites. The assessment was carried out in September 2022 and involved online research only. Table 1 defines the traffic lights approach, while Table 2 shows the availability of the 52 pieces of information.

In addition to the traffic lights assessment, all information was divided into one of two categories:⁷

• Static – covering legislation, regulations, procedures, guidance, structures or other norms that typically need to be published only once; and contracts, agreements, reports and maps, which may expire or be revised, but which generally remain constant over a period of time. These might be referred to as 'pdf information', based on the format they are typically published in. All static information might reasonably be expected to be available on the FDA or other official Liberia websites, as this is the easiest way of showing that it has been published, and for it then to be accessed by members of the public. This would also enable organizations to download and print out the information, to pass on to those without internet access. Whilst hard copies may be in circulation, this does not necessarily satisfy the obligations in the VPA annex.

• **Live** – covering business registration, timber production, revenue flows, enforcement actions, social obligations and other information that may change daily.

The assessment led to the proposal to include a number of additional pieces of information, which are presented in Table 3, below the main assessment table.

In addition, a similar assessment has been conducted under the Multi-stakeholder Forest Governance and Accountability Project (MFGAP), also in September 2022. Rather than only considering online sources, this assessment included contacting the FDA and other relevant regulatory authorities in Liberia to assess the availability of information on request and/or through hard-copy distribution. The results of this MFGAP survey are integrated into Table 2 and Table 3 *as comments in italics*. It assessed the 39 items, including many of those in the VPA annex but also some additional ones relating to community forestry. The 39 items were identified as priorities for access through the proposed public portal in LiberTrace. Although the MFGAP assessment used a similar traffic lights system, this has not been incorporated into the tables.


Assessment

The assessment of availability of the 52 pieces of information identified in VPA Annex IX leads to the following observations.

The analysis has established that while the FDA website exists, major documents and data relevant to the sector that are required to be published in accordance with Annex IX are not found on it. The majority of the laws and regulations cited in the VPA are not available on the official FDA website. While they may be published on other websites, including those of inter-governmental organizations such as the EU and FAO, or of NGOs, these organizations do not have the same legal duty as the Liberian regulatory authorities, and their information could be removed at any time.

The FDA website itself is inconsistent. The web pages for 'Laws and Regulations' and 'SGS Liberia Reports' (for example) are intuitively the places one might look for the respective documents, but many of these documents are only to be found on other pages, such as 'Documents' or the SGS's own LiberTrace website. Furthermore, one of the more comprehensive catalogues of laws and regulations is buried under three sublinks from the FDA's homepage, and in such a way (using Google Drive) that search engines would not be able to find its contents (Figure 1).8

The assessment also found that major contracts such as FMCs, TSCs, CFMAs, Social Agreements and Commercial Use Contracts (CUCs) are not accessible on the official website of FDA. The LEITI also has a responsibility to publish forest sector contacts, and its website has eight (out of ten) TSCs, and five (out of seven) FMCs. It has no CFMAs or CUCs, even though its most recent report lists 21 companies as operating in CFMAs.⁹ As a result, communities may not have sufficient knowledge of the terms and conditions of the signed contracts, including any revenue-sharing or other benefits that affected communities have a right to.

The assessment also highlighted the fact that where documents have been revised, there can be confusion as to which is the current version. For example, the Code of Forest Harvesting Practices is more up to date on the EU's FLEGT website than on the FDA's, whereas for the Compliance and Enforcement Handbook the

opposite is the case. This demonstrates the importance of having a website, managed effectively by a relevant regulatory authority, that is easy to navigate, user-friendly and current.

There is even less information about the extent to which logging companies actually meet the obligations to communities contained in Social Agreements or CUCs. This makes it almost impossible for communities to know if the company is fully up to date with Land Rental Fee payments, what volume of timber has been harvested over a particular period, or if the associated Cubic Meter Fees have been paid. This type of 'live' information needs to be the main focus of the proposed public portal in LiberTrace. The absence of accurate, official, and up-to-date information also prevents other organizations – such as the National Unions of CFMBs and of CFDCs, and the Liberia Timber Association – from knowing the national picture regarding arrears. It also leads to much time being wasted trying to establish the accuracy of various different published datasets.

Where Social Agreements, CUCs and periodic reports from communities are not in the public domain, it is hard to know what has been promised with regard to community infrastructure, and how far such obligations are being met. As with the issue of payments of Land Rental and Cubic Meter Fees, access to such information is crucial to enable ordinary community members to hold their own representative committees – CFMBs and CFDCs – to account for supervising the implementation of any agreement with logging companies.

The assessment identified eight of the items as 'live', i.e. information that changes on an almost daily basis, and which should be made available through a public portal. It identified 42 of the items as 'static', i.e. information that changes less often, is typically published as a pdf file, and could easily be made available on the FDA or other official Liberia website. Of the 20 proposed additional items (Table 3), 12 are in the 'static' category, and eight are 'live' data.

Comparison with the assessment conducted in 2012 indicates that 13 types of information have fallen from a green 'available' ranking to a 'partially available' ranking. This is mainly due to a significant reduction in the documents published on the FDA website. A further four have fallen from 'available' to 'not available', and three from 'partially available' to 'not available'. However, three items have shown greater availability: the General Business Law (1978), the Decent Work Act (2015), and maps of community forests and their areas.
